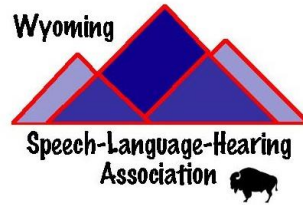


WYOMING SPEECH, LANGUAGE and HEARING ASSOCIATION (WSHA) SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION



Eligibility

- Open to currently enrolled **graduate** students (distance and on-campus) in the Division of Communication Disorders at the University of Wyoming.

Award

- Scholarships will be awarded to eligible **graduate** students to off-set the costs of tuition, books and supplies. Awards will be announced at the Division of Communication Disorders spring banquet. Funds will be dispersed before the next academic semester.

Application materials

1. A copy of current transcript (unofficial/WYO WEB format is acceptable)
2. Typed-written statement that includes the following information: (*no more than two typed pages; double-spaced; 12-point font*)
 - *Brief* biography (i.e., tell us who you are and how you came to be in this profession)
 - Statement of professional goals (i.e., *after* completing graduate school)
 - A response to the following statement:
